

STOVE FLOOR PLATES

Show off your new contemporary pellet or wood burning stove at it's best on a floor plate; a simple and effective way to make a hearth for your stove.

Our floor plates come in many shapes and sizes, custom manufactured from **12mm** toughened glass.

Building regulations

If a stove is placed on a combustible floor then the hearth must be at least 250mm thick (or 125mm thick with a 50mm air gap underneath). This hearth thickness can be reduced to 12mm if the stove does not raise the hearth temperature to 100 degrees centigrade.

Many stove manufacturers have tested their stoves and should be able to state that their stove does not raise the hearth temperature to 100 degrees C, or that it does. It is the contemporary stoves that often have wood stores/sections underneath that often do not heat the hearth to more than 100 degrees.

You should bear in mind that if you are using a 6mm glass floor plate or a 2mm steel plate on a combustible floor that you should place another non-combustible layer under the floor plate to bring the total up to the 12mm required by regulations (we do not sell 6mm unless requested).
